



This little lady is well protected against wintry blasts in her smart accessories set, gaily patterned in Fair Isle. Designed for a four-year-old, the set is equally suitable and attractive for boy or girl.

fair isle beret, scarf and mitts

MATERIALS

3 oz. knitting wool, 3-ply, natural;
½ oz. brown; ½ oz. yellow;
¼ oz. green; ¼ oz. white.
A pair each Nos. 13, 11 and 10
knitting needles.
A No. 1 steel crochet hook.

TENSION (for Fair Isle):

Using No. 10 needles 8½ st. and
11 rows to 1 sq. in.

COLOUR ABBREVIATIONS

N, natural; B, brown; Y, yellow;
G, green; W, white.

THE BERET

With No. 13 needles and N, cast on
136 st.

1st row.—K. 3, * P. 2, K. 2. Rep
from * to last st., K. 1.



THE MITTS (both alike)

With No. 11 needles and N, cast on 44 st.

Work 3 in. in the rib., inc. at both ends of last row (46 st.).

Work 12 rows st.st.

Rep. 1st to 16th rows of the Fair Isle patt.

Work 10 rows using N. dec. 1 st. at end of last row (45 st.).

Continue in N, shaping top as follows:—

39th row.—* K. 3, K. 2 tog. Rep. from * to end.

40th to 42nd rows.—Work in st.st.

41st row.—* K. 2, K. 2 tog. Rep. from * to end.

42nd row.—P.

43rd row.—* K. 1, K. 2 tog. Rep. from * to end.

44th row.—P.

45th row.—* K. 2 tog. to end.

Break off wool, draw up stitches with needle and end of wool.

THUMBS (both alike).—Using N and No. 11 needles, cast on 2 st. Work in st.st., inc. at both ends of every 3rd row until there are 16 st. on needle. Work 1½ in. without shaping.

Last row.—K. 2 tog. to end. Break off wool, draw up st. with needle and end of wool.

Close-up showing details of the set. Note the mitts have thumbs, and long gauntlet cuffs to give extra warmth.

SCARF

With No. 10 needles and N, cast on 44 st. Work 1½ in. in the rib, inc. at both ends of last row (46 st.). Work 2 rows st.st. Work 16 rows Fair Isle patt. Continue in N. Work 2 rows st.st., dec. at both ends of last row (44 st.). Work in the rib until work measures 32½ in. from beg. Work 2 rows st.st., inc. at both ends of last row (46 st.). Work 16 rows Fair Isle patt. Continue in N. Work 2 rows st.st., dec. at both ends of last row (44 st.). Work 1½ in. in the rib. Cast off.

To Make Up.—Sew seam of beret. Sew seams of mitts, leaving spaces for thumbs. Sew seams of thumbs and stitch into spaces. With No. 1 steel crochet hook and N, work 1 row d.c. down each side of scarf, working 1 d.c. into every alternate row. Press with hot iron over damp cloth.
