

SUCH A SUNNY DESIGN!

A PRETTY fancy rib patterning, a sunray ribbed collar, and the new "elbow" sleeves make this little knitted jumper a real triumph.

MATERIALS

Use 4 balls of "Anchor Tricoton" (shade F. 443) and 1 pair each of Milward's "Phantom" knitting pins No. 10 and No. 12.

Work at a tension of 7 sts. to the inch in width for a 33-34-inch bust size.

THE FRONT

With No. 12 needles cast on 148 sts. and work in ribbing of k. 2, p. 2 for 2 inches.

Next row : P. 7, * p. 2 tog., p. 2; repeat from * till 5 remain, p. 5 (114 sts.).

Change to No. 10 needles and work in pattern as follows, the 1st row being right side of work :

1st row : ** P. 6 *. Then, with thread in front of work, slip the next 2 sts. on to right-hand needle, then take the thread to the back of the work, in front of the 2 slipped sts., pass the 2 slipped sts. back on to the left-hand needle, and then k. them off.* Repeat from * to * twice more**. Now repeat from ** to ** till 6 remain, p. 6.

2nd row : * K. 6, p. 6; repeat from * till 6 remain, k. 6.

These 2 rows form the pattern. Work in pattern for 12 more rows. Then, still working in pattern, inc. 1 st. at each end of the next row and every 6th row after (by knitting twice into the first and last st.), until there are 130 sts. on needle. Then continue in pattern without further shaping until work measures 11 inches from the beginning. Then shape the armholes by casting off 8 at the beginning of the next 2 rows and then k. 2 tog. at the beginning and end of the next 9 rows (96 sts.). Then work in pattern till work measures 15½ inches, finishing with the 2nd pattern row. Then shape neck as follows :

1st row : Work 44 sts. in pattern, cast off 8, work in pattern to end of row.

*** Working on the last set of 44 sts. for right side of front, k. 2 tog. at neck edge every row for 12 rows. Then shape shoulder :

1st row : Cast off 6, work in pattern till 2 remain, k. 2 tog.

2nd row : K. 2 tog., then pattern to end.

Then cast off 6 at the beginning of the next 4 rows that start at armhole edge.

Join thread to neck edge of other side and work 1 row, then work as first shoulder from ***.

THE BACK

Work as the front till the armhole shaping is finished, then continue in pattern till work measures 15 inches from the beginning,

finishing with the 2nd pattern row. Then make a back opening :

1st row : Work 51 sts. in pattern; turn.

2nd row : Work on these 51 sts. in pattern.

3rd row (on this row make a buttonhole): Work in pattern till 6 remain, k. 1, cast off 3, k. 2.

4th row : Work in pattern, casting on 3 where 3 were cast off in previous row.

Now work in pattern on these 51 sts. till work measures 17 inches from the beginning, finishing with the 2nd pattern row. Make a buttonhole on the next 2 rows as before. Then start shaping the shoulder by casting off 6 at the beginning of every row that starts at armhole edge until 21 sts. remain. Cast off. Join thread to centre edge of remaining 45 sts.

1st row : Cast on 6, k. 6 (the cast-on sts.), work in pattern to end of row.

Now work in pattern on these 51 sts., keeping the 6 sts. at centre edge in st.-st. (k. on right side, p. on wrong side) till work measures 17 inches from the beginning. Then cast off 6 at the beginning of every row that starts at armhole edge until 21 sts. remain. Cast off.

THE SLEEVES (both alike)

With No. 12 needles cast on 78 sts. and work in ribbing of k. 2, p. 2 for 1 inch. Then change to No. 10 needles and work in pattern as given for the back, but inc. 1 st. at each end of the 7th row and every

6th row after, until there are 90 sts. on needle. Then work in pattern without shaping until sleeve measures 7½ inches from the beginning. Now shape the top by casting off 6 at the beginning of the next 2 rows, and then k. 2 tog. at each end of every row until 18 sts. remain. Cast off.

THE COLLAR

With No. 12 needles cast on 242 sts. and work in ribbing as follows :

1st row : P. 2, * k. 4, p. 2; repeat from * to end of row.

2nd row : * K. 2, p. 4; repeat from * till 2 remain, k. 2.

Repeat these 2 rows 12 times.

27th row : P. 2, * k. 2 tog., k. 2, p. 2; repeat from * to end of row.

28th row : * K. 2, p. 3; repeat from * till 2 remain, k. 2.

29th row : P. 2, * k. 3, p. 2; repeat from * to end of row.

Repeat the last 2 rows 11 times, then work the 28th row once more.

53rd row : P. 2, * k. 2 tog., k. 1, p. 2; repeat from * to end of row.

54th row : * K. 2, p. 2; repeat from * till 2 remain, k. 2.

Continue in k. 2, p. 2 ribbing till collar measures 6½ inches. Cast off.

MAKING UP

Join all seams and sew in sleeves. Sew down the under flap of the opening on the wrong side. Sew the cast-off edge of the collar to the neck edge of the jumper. Sew on buttons.

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
