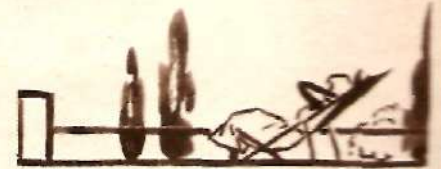


CHARM FOR THE AFTERNOON



edges of the jabots. Join all other seams and sew in sleeves, and sew on collar. Sew button to neck edge of left front and make a loop on right front.

YOU'LL love making this little afternoon jumper. The shape is pretty and the effective openwork stitch is formed with a simple one-row pattern!

MATERIALS

Use 4 balls of "Anchor Tricoton" (shade F.567) and 1 pair each of Milward's "Phantom" knitting pins No. 10 and No. 12

Worked at a tension of about 15 sts. to 2 inches in width and 8 rows to the inch, this jumper should fit a 32 3/4-inch bust size figure.

THE BACK

With No. 12 needles cast on 116 sts. and work in ribbing of k. 1, p. 1 for 2 1/2 inches.

Next row: P. 13, * p. 2 tog., p. 2; repeat from * till 7 remain, p. 7 (92 sts.).

Change to No. 10 needles and work in pattern, which is comprised of one row only.

Pattern row: K. 1, * k. 2 tog., p. and k. into front of next st.; repeat from * till 1 remains, k. 1.

Work in pattern for 8 rows. Then, keeping the continuity of pattern, inc. 1 st. at each end of the next row and every 4th row after (by knitting twice into the first and last st. and knitting plain the odd sts, at ends when increasing to keep the pattern correct between inc. rows) until you have added 18 extra sts. (110 sts.). Then work without shaping until work measures 11 inches from the beginning. Shape the armholes by casting off 6 at the beginning of the next 2 rows and then k. 2 tog. at the beginning and end of the next 6 rows. Work without shaping till armhole measures 6 inches on the straight from the beginning. Then shape the shoulders by casting off 7 at the beginning of the next 8 rows. Cast off remainder.

THE FRONT

With No. 12 needles cast on 116 sts. and work in ribbing of k. 1, p. 1 for 2 1/2 inches. Change to No. 10 needles and work in pattern for 4 inches. Then, still working in pattern, inc. 1 st. at each end of the next row and every 4th row until sts. number 128. Then continue without further increasing till work measures 10 inches from start.

Next row: Work 64 sts. in pattern; turn.

Continuing work only on these 64 sts., work next row in pattern.

Now continue on these sts. for 6 more rows, knitting 2 tog. at inside edge every row.

Next row: Starting at armhole edge, cast off 6, work in pattern till 2 remain, k. 2 tog.

Next row: K. 2 tog., work in pattern to end of row.

Now continue knitting in pattern, knitting 2 tog. at the beginning and end of every row till 30 sts. remain. Cast off. Join thread to centre edge of other side.

1st row: Work in pattern to end of row. Work 6 more rows in pattern on these sts., knitting 2 tog. at centre edge every row.

Next row: Cast off 6, work in pattern till 2 remain, k. 2 tog.

Next row: K. 2 tog., work in pattern to end of row.

Now continue in pattern, knitting 2 tog. at each end of every row till 30 sts. remain. Cast off.

THE SLEEVES (both alike)

With No. 12 needles cast on 92 sts. and work in ribbing of k. 1, p. 1 for 2 1/2 inches. Change to No. 10 needles and work in pattern till sleeve measures 7 inches. Then cast off 9 at the beginning of the next 2

rows and then k. 2 tog. at each end of every row till 12 sts. remain. Cast off.

YOKE AND JABOTS (two pieces alike)

With No. 10 needles cast on 32 sts. and, working in pattern, inc. 1 st. at each end of every 8th row for 5 increases.

Next row: K. 2 tog. at start of row, k. to within 1 st. of end, k. twice into last st.

Next row: K. twice into first st., k. to within 2 sts of end, k. 2 tog.

Repeat these 2 rows for a further 3 1/2 inches. Then continue decreasing on the same edge as before, but keep the other edge straight until all the sts. have been worked off.

THE COLLAR

With No. 10 needles cast on 11 sts. and

work in pattern, casting on 4 at the beginning of every row until there are 71 sts. on needle, then cast on 3 sts. at start of next row. Then work 12 rows without shaping.

Next row: Work 18 sts. in pattern, cast off 38, work in pattern to end of row.

Now continue in pattern on the last set of 18 sts. for 32 rows, but at the same time increasing 1 st. every row on the outside edge for 17 rows, then keep this edge straight for 6 rows, and then dec. 1 st. every row on this edge for the remaining 9 rows, knitting 2 tog. at inside edge every alternate row. Cast off loosely.

Join thread to inside edge of other side, and work this to correspond.

TO MAKE UP

Sew yoke pieces to top of front so that the straight edges of the yoke form the lower
